

Thank you for purchasing this Pondmaster product. This continuous duty pump is designed for use inside a pond skimmer to move large volumes of water silently and efficiently through filtration systems or to a waterfall, stream or fountain. It incorporates a high efficiency vortex impeller in conjunction with a ceramic impeller shaft and bearings to provide energy savings while maintaining high output.

This pump must be used partially or fully submersed inside a pond skimmer, indoors or outdoors. **Never run this pump dry.**

Rotor assembly is removable for simple cleaning maintenance. The unique design reduces the frequency of pump cleaning while maintaining optimum water flow. Overload protection is built-in by means of a self-resetting thermal overload switch.

WARNING RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK

This pump is supplied with a grounding conductor and grounding type attachment plug. NEVER REMOVE GROUND PIN FROM PLUG. To reduce the risk of electric shock, be certain that it is connected only to properly grounded, grounding-type receptacle. The national Electric Code requires that a ground fault interrupter circuit (GFCI) be installed in every branch circuit supplying the fountain or pond equipment. Your dealer can supply GFCI units.

Do not immerse the plug in water. DO NOT REACH INTO THE WATER TO REMOVE THE PLUG. TURN OFF CIRCUIT FIRST. A "drip loop" in the cords should be used. A "drip loop" is a loop in the cord below the level of the receptacle or plug that prevents water from traveling along the cord.

WARNING: FOR YOUR PROTECTION, ALWAYS UNPLUG THE UNIT FROM ITS POWER SOURCE BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING. DO NOT REACH, REMOVE OR DISASSEMBLE BEFORE YOU DISCONNECT POWER.

OPERATION PRECAUTIONS

- Never run pump dry. Maintain water level to keep pump intake and output submersed.
- Only use this pump with clean water. It is not intended to move water containing large non-dissolved solids.
- Never use pump for liquids other than water.
- Do not place directly in silt or sand.
- Never pull the pump from a pond by pulling the power cord.
- Never remove the plug or shorten the power cord.
- Keep the connectors (Plug and Socket) dry.
- The pump is not suitable for use in swimming pools, swimming ponds and other situations where persons could make bodily contact with the water.
- Never use the pump if the power cord is damaged in any way. A damaged pump cord can not be changed; pump must be discarded.
- If motor is clogged disconnect power before servicing since thermal protector may have temporarily turned off motor and it may restart without warning once cool.

NEVER ALLOW STANDING WATER TO FREEZE IN PUMP OR CONNECTIONS.


Pump must always be either partially or completely immersed in water inside a Skimmer or Pump Vault.

For all Installations: Make certain that all electrical connections have a GFCI installed. Always use Teflon tape on threaded fittings to aid in future disassembly. Place O-Rings over male threads on fittings. Protect the intake from leaves and

other debris getting drawn into the Impeller by using a Pump Bag around the pump before placing the Pump into a Skimmer or Pump Vault.

CUT OFF ANY EXTRA SMALL SECTIONS OF STEPPED BARB CONNECTORS THAT RESTRICT FLOW RATE.






MAINTENANCE and CLEANING:

This Pump does not require any lubrication or special maintenance. Periodically cleaning the Impeller will maintain Pump performance and extend Pump life.

- 1) Disconnect Pump from power supply completely.
- 2) Remove hosés and bring Pump to clear work area.
- 3) Rotate Intake Pre-Filter counter clockwise, remove and set aside.
- 4) Remove 4 screws **B**, detach Motor Cover from Motor.



- 6) Clean Impeller, Chamber and Pre-Filter with fresh water only, never any solvents. If scale on surface is present, soak in white vinegar / water solution to soften scale for easy removal. Rinse clean completely with clear water.
- 7) Reverse steps to reassemble. If Rubber Seal becomes dislodged, make certain it is clean and place it back into the recess on the Motor cover.
- 8) Align the Impeller plate (F) with the recess in the Motor Cover before inserting Impeller assembly back into Motor.

WINTERIZATION and STORAGE

If Pump is outdoors in areas with harsh winters it should be removed from shallow water that may freeze. Either place into deep water or if removed, it must be cleaned with plain water and dried before being put into storage. If Pump will be turned off for long periods of time and left under the water in non-freezing areas, debris may accumulate inside the Pump. Before reinstallation flush Pump with clean water. It is strongly recommended to perform an Impeller maintenance as well to thoroughly clean the Impeller and chamber.


